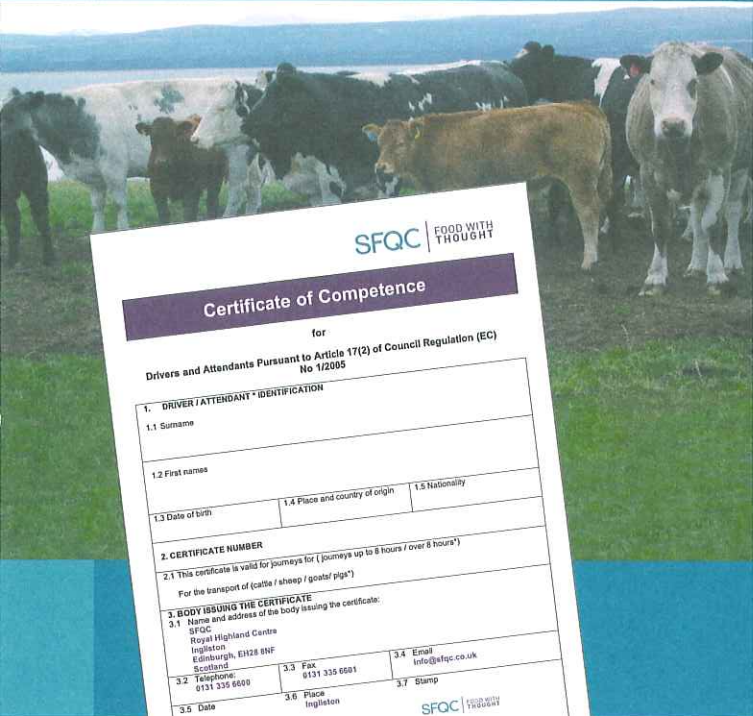


**ARE YOU
A COMPETENT
DRIVER?**

Council Regulation (EC) 1/2005 states that from the 5th January 2008 transporters of livestock on all journeys over 65km will need to hold a Certificate of Competence.

- The Certificate for Short Journeys (over 65km and up to 8 hours) can be gained through SFQC by sitting and passing a multiple choice test.
- Transporters of livestock on Long Journeys (over 8 hours) require an additional practical assessment of their competence including driving and animal handling skills. Please contact SFQC on 0131 335 6641 for further information.
- The Certificate of Competence is valid for life (similar to a driving licence).

How to confirm your Assessment

Obtaining a Certificate of Competence Information Pack

To obtain your Certificate of Competence Information Pack please complete the application form and send with your cheque to SFQC, Royal Highland Centre, Ingliston, Edinburgh EH28 8NF.

Once your cheque is received, a receipt and Information Pack (including booklet), which will include further information about the assessment, will be sent to you.

Details of the assessment centres, together with the dates and times of the tests will be included with the Information Pack.

Preparation for the Assessment

Reading the booklet is not a pre-requisite for an application for an assessment, but potential applicants are strongly advised that they are aware of the competencies expected of them when they are assessed.

What you will need to supply at the Assessment?

You will be required to produce photographic ID with your signature and your current driving licence (both parts of the new licence) in order to be allowed to sit the test.

What happens after the Assessment?

The Certificate of Competence will be sent directly to you if you have passed the assessment. If, however you have not passed you will be contacted by SFQC to arrange another time, suitable to you, to resit the assessment, and this will incur an additional charge.
