Photo Competition Entry Details and Terms & Conditions

- The theme of the competition is that images should reflect:

Crofting, the landscape, the people and the animals... or all three.

- The winning images selected by members of the SCF Board will be reproduced on notecards for sale on the Scottish Crofting Enterprise website.
- The closing date for entries is October 31st 2017
- Entrants aged under 16 years must have the permission of their parent or guardian before entering the competition.
- The judges' decision is final and all winners will be notified of their success. Winners will receive a canvas of their print.
- All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. You must seek the permission from persons included in your photo before submitting it to the competition. If there are person/s under 16 years of age you must have the parent/guardian's permission to enter the image to the competition. Please include a copy of this with your entry.
- All entries must be in high resolution digital format and emailed to hq@crofting.org
- Please include the title of your entry, name, brief description and age (if under 16).
- By entering the competition you give SCF the right to use your image on the SCF notecards, SCF/SCE website, SCF social media and SCF publications (The Crofter). A credit will be given but no fee will be paid.
- Your details will not be passed to third parties.
- By entering the competition you are agreeing to these terms and conditions.
